We're doing it again! The fourth annual "Love Life" conference will be held in Edmonton on Saturday, November 7, 2009, from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm. Under the theme "*Life On The Edge*," this year's conference will consider several life-related issues. Co-sponsored by Lutherans For Life-Canada, Concordia Lutheran Seminary, and Concordia University College of Alberta, it takes place at CUCA's Robert Tegler Student Centre. The conference features two great speakers.

- **The Rev. Dr. Robert Weise** will speak on "Cloning for Stem Cells: The Art of 'Celling' Your Self ." He holds a doctoral degree in zoology as well as a master's degree in theology, speaks widely on medical ethics, and serves in a unique way as professor of bioethics and pastoral ministry at Concordia Seminary in St. Louis, MO.
- **Dr. John Patrick, M.D.**, is back again to speak on two topics: "How Did We Get To Here? How Abortion Became Acceptable" and "On Using Our Own Language in the Public Sphere." He is a retired professor from the University of Ottawa, and a popular speaker on ethical issues in medicine and culture, and the relation of faith and science.

This year's conference lets both speakers lead two one-hour sessions, each of which is followed by a 15-minute period of questions and comments. Displays and exhibits will be provided by a range of pro-life groups and individuals.

The cost of the conference is \$25 by October 31. Registering at the door costs \$30. Students pay \$10 either way. Lunch is included, and parking is free on the Concordia campus.
