The **GCTS** is awarded after successful completion of twenty four credits or eight courses in the Open Studies program. It can be completed in one year, or up to eight years, and can serve as a bridge between Open Studies and a Master's degree program at Concordia Lutheran Seminary or another ATS-accredited seminary.

Are you up for the challenge?

Not everyone who studies at CLS is preparing for the pastoral office...

...but everyone who studies *does* have the opportunity to earn graduate level credits that are applicable to other Seminary programs *and* transferable to other accredited seminaries in North America.

Course Delivery

Courses are offered in conjunction with the Master of Divinity program. While the majority of courses meet 2 or 3 times per week for 13 weeks, there are also regular offerings of short term (2 week) classes in December, January, and May, and occasional offerings of once per week and evening courses over a full semester.

Who Can Apply?

Anyone with an undergraduate degree, the appropriate course prerequisites, and the willingness to learn, grow, and serve is eligible to study at the Seminary.
